Wednesday 6th December

Melbourne Groups assemble at the NZ airlines counter, Tullamarine for group check-in on flight NZ124 departing 1210 (12.10pm), arriving in Auckland 1740 (5.40pm). Sydney groups assemble at Air NZ Airlines counter Kingsford Smith Airport for group check-in on flight NZ104 departing 1145 (11.45am), arriving in Auckland 1645 (4.45pm). Groups will be transported in 12seater mini buses provided by Metropolitan Rentals Ltd to Hamilton in readiness for the Waikato Pepsi Cola Junior Tournament, where they will be accommodated for the duration of the event at the Wintec Accommodation Services University Residence, 181 Collingwood Street, Hamilton Ph: (001164)7 834 9224 where the group will spend the next 7 nights.

Thursday 7th December to Tuesday 12th December

The group will be participating in the Waikato - Pepsi Cola Junior Tournament. This Tournament will be conducted at the Waikato Tennis Centre, Logan Park Drive, Hamilton. The venue features 7 synthetic grass, 18 plexipave & 3 indoor rebound ace tennis courts. Manager and Administrator organiser Waikato Thames Valley is Roslyn Simmonds.

Wednesday 13th December

The group will then be departing Hamilton @ approx. 8.30am for Napier (Hawkes Bay) where the group will participate in the Hawkes Bay Junior International Open. Thursday 14th December to Sunday 17th December

During this time the groups will compete in the Hawkes Bay Junior International Open held at the Hawkes Bay Tennis Club, 13 Higgins Street, Mawera, Napier which features 10 Synthetic Grass courts & the Greendale Tennis Club, Symons Lane, Taradale which feature 9 Synthetic grass courts will be utilised .Tournament organiser is Sarah Shand.

Friday 15th December

There will be a disco, dinner and presentation at the Hawkes BayTennis Club @6.30pm for the entire touring party.

Sunday 17th December

The Basic Concept

To have the opportunity to visit and experience a foreign culture, compete in the New Zealand Summer Tennis circuit with the opportunity to foster and develop life lasting friendships.

The Function of "Kanga"

Kanga Tennis Tours International selects suitable Tennis Tournaments, accommodation and methods of transportation in New Zealand. Whilst in Australia, the travellers are being prepared for the visit through meetings and literature.

The Group Directors Function

A unique feature of Kanga Tennis Tours International is the experienced personnel, with a strong background in Tennis, who are employed to organise and manage these tours. Directors are selected from the interested, well qualified, successful Tennis Coaching Professionals. They assume a great responsibility, with many facets of the trip to co-ordinate. They are responsible for selecting and preparing the group for overseas travel whilst in Australia. In addition to this, they become the 'communication centre' for the group whilst overseas.

The Necessary Qualifications for the Traveller

The ages of the traveller may vary from approximately 9-19 years of age, but any young adult may be considered. Travellers should have an adaptable, friendly personality, with an emotionally stable disposition. They must be prepared to be flexible and adjust to a different culture as well as displaying a co-operative and responsible attitude toward the group director:

Supervising the Travellers

The State & Group Directors

The travellers are under the charge of the Directors or anybody designated by these people for the entire duration of the trip.

Getting Involved in "Kanga"

Interested parents and youngsters are asked to attend an Orientation meeting. Here, the trip is explained in greater detail and any questions answered. A deposit of \$500.00 can be made at this meeting as a means of securing a position on the trip.

Expectations of the Traveller

The Travellers are expected to be flexible and adaptable. Although this is a Tennis Tour, there will be cultural differences such as lifestyle, food, habits etc. and these are to be expected and well-tolerated. A little homesickness is to be expected and the State and Group Directors are always available to help. Travellers are reminded that they are representing their families, their sport and themselves. Their behaviour will be a reflection on their country too.

Rules

- I. No drinking or alcoholic beverages
- No smoking
- 3. Do not borrow money
- Show a willingness to obey requests from the State Director, Group Director or Tournament hosts
- Obey the laws of the country you are visiting

In the unfortunate event of severe misconduct, arrangements may be made to return the offending traveller to his or her parents, with the responsibility of any additional expenses incurred by the parents.





Tennis and the Cultural Concept

Kanga Tennis Tours International aims to strike a good balance between the cultural and the sport aspects of the tour. Restrictions are not generally placed on the ability level of the teams or individuals and every endeavour is made to match the skill level of the group with tournaments and matches organised.
